



Installing and Using Leg Mounting Cleats (Parts #3912 and #3913)

Are you looking for a stylish solution to mounting your table legs? The Straight and Angled Leg Mounting Cleats from Osborne Wood Products are exactly what you need! These wooden components can be finished to match your table design and will not even look like hardware. No need for a table skirt. These are perfect for achieving the Mid-Century Modern look!

What you need:

- Leg Mounting Cleats – Straight (**Part #3912**) or Angled – 12 degrees (**Part #3913**). These are sold in a set of two, accommodating a standard four-legged table.
- Drill
- Tape measure
- Pencil
- Tabletop (of your choice)
- Table legs (of your choice)
- 4 - 3/8" Hanger Bolts (**Part #938**). One for each leg.

Installation instructions:

1. First, center your cleats on your tabletop. Use the table legs to decide how far inwards you would like to position your cleat from the edge of the table so your legs land exactly where you would like for them to. Mark around the edges of the cleat with a pencil.
2. With your cleat positioned within your pencil markings, use screws to secure the cleat to the tabletop via the pre-drilled screw holes.
3. It's that easy! The cleats are now installed and you can add your table legs.
4. The cleats accept 3/8" hanger bolts, which must be installed into your table legs. Make sure to keep 1" of the bolt revealed at the top of the table leg as the depth of the cleat will accept 1" of a bolt.
5. Once the hanger bolts are installed into the table legs, simply screw the legs onto the cleats! Now you have a complete table!
